Dear Ms Rundell,

Proposed amendments to the Royal Charter for Carnegie Dunfermline Trust.

I have recently visited the Carnegie Dunfermline Trust offices in Dunfermline and viewed the draft Supplemental Charter. My concerns in this regard are well know, and where before I was suspicious—I am now convinced that the new proposed terms for the Royal Charter are in the main designed to facilitate the carve-up of The Glen by creating and “Outer Glen” on the fringes, and an “Inner Glen” in the core of Pittencrieff Park.

Given the strength of feeling locally and the number of people who have supported our (Pittencrieff Park Support group’s) petition I will be hiring a large hall in the next few weeks with a view to holding a public meeting at which I will be announcing my findings to the general public—who will be invited to attend free of charge.

Given that you and your Chairman Angus Hogg have, via the press, rubbished my interpretation of the proposed amendments to the Royal Charter I would extend an invitation to you both to attend the meeting and put your view to the public in order that we can debate and clarify the situation re The Glen. I think that this is necessary as your stated position, that the changes to the charter are concerned with bringing the charter up to date with new charitable rules, is at odds with the terms of the Supplemental Charter.

As I will have to move quickly to advertise the meeting, book premises, and find an impartial public figure prepared to chair the meeting. I have pencilled in the date of Saturday 14th October for a venue within Dunfermline.

Please confirm whether or not Angus Hogg and your good self are available to address and take part in my public meeting (on that date or some other convenient date) to debate this very important matter?
