Case Enquiries

Whilst the Trustees are keen to assist family members and descendants wishing to find out more about cases which have affected them or their family we are mindful of issues of confidentiality and respect relating to individual cases and therefore advise:

To make enquiries about a case where a Hero has been recognised please write to the Chief Executive with the following information:

- name of person whose heroism was recognised by this Trust
- your relationship to them
- date, place and nature of the incident which took place and any further details known to you
- state if you have a copy of the certificate
- if not, state how did you find out about the award

The Trustees will endeavour to provide as much assistance as they can in answering queries but reserve the right to only release such information as is available or appropriate to the enquiry.

The Roll of Honour is displayed in a glass case in the Birthplace Museum and individual requests regarding viewing of specific entries are subject to the same procedure as above.
