## REVITALISING PITTENCREIFF PARK

**Through the Developing Dunfermline Partnership, a working group has been established to look at the future development of one of the town's most important recreational assets - Pittencrieff Park.**

Led by Dr Alexander Lawson, the group has set as its long-term aim, the re-establishment of the Park as one of the premier family attractions in Scotland. Widely regarded as one of the country's finest urban parks, it has an important design landscape, a spectacular Glen, and many fine listed buildings.

A contribution of £10,000 from the Trust will enable consultants to produce a Master Plan for all future developments and initiatives in the Park over the next 10 years.

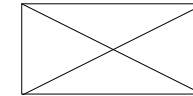

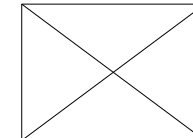
